

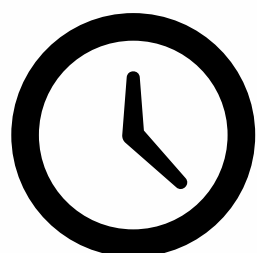

FIX THE LEAKY SCHOOL ROOF



at Martinson elementary school

The Martinson Elementary School has a leaking roof that is in need of repair. At the fall town meeting, we voted to repair the roof; now the town must pass a debt exclusion as part of a special election on January 10th to pay for the repairs. Join our team in working to build awareness about the special election and reminding our neighbors to vote on January 10 to support fixing the leak.

The total estimated cost of the school roof renovation is \$3.4 million, but the town is not required to fund the entire cost due to an agreement with the Massachusetts School Building Authority (MSBA), which will reimburse the town for 49.1% of the total project cost. The project is expected to cost the average Marshfield homeowner—with a property value of

\$758,000—about \$30.35 per year.
